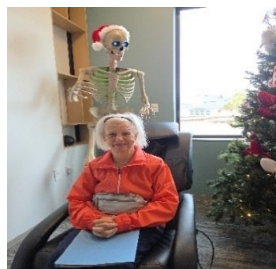

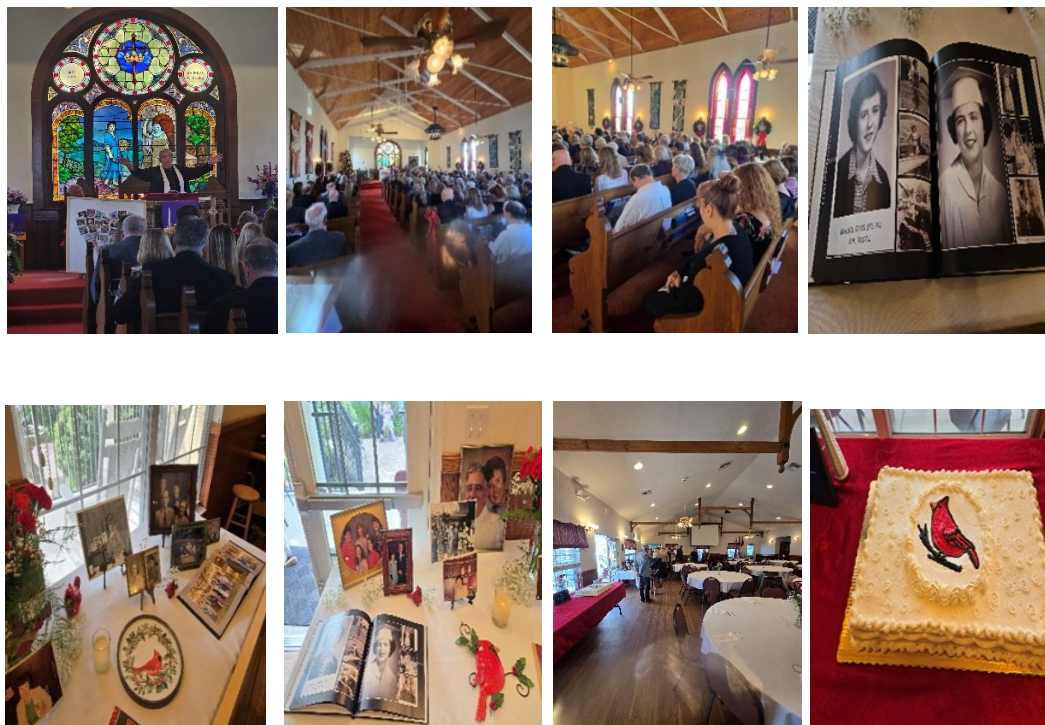


Memories of Pat Stump
